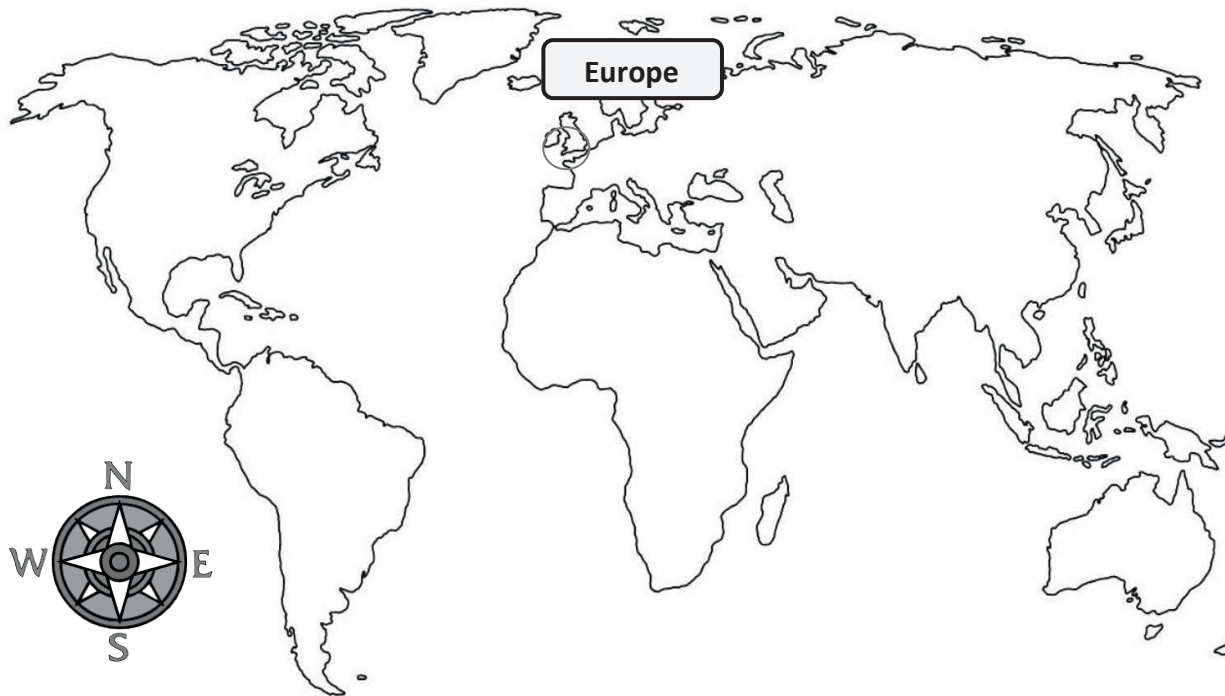


Can you find Wales on the map?

Animals: Look at the map of Wales on the next page. Can you name the animals that live there?

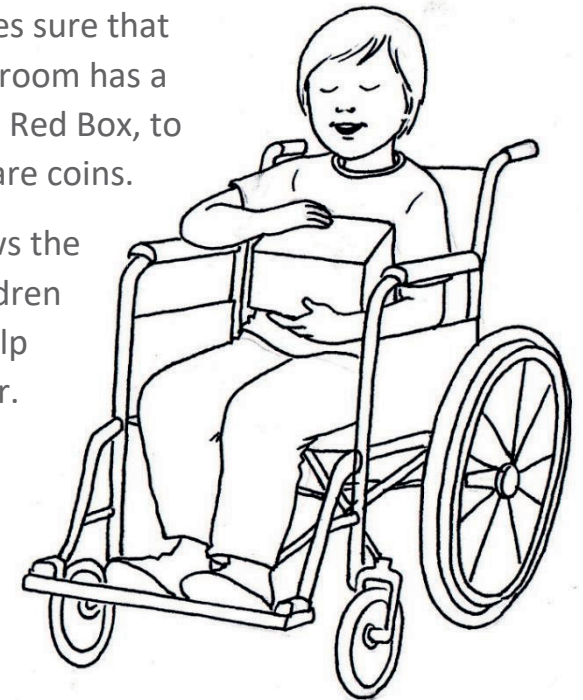
Rhys lives with his mum and dad in Wales. His mum works in a shop and his dad works in a factory.

Praying the Mission Rosary helps Rhys know that he is part of God's worldwide family.

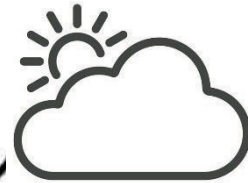

MissioTfal Prayer

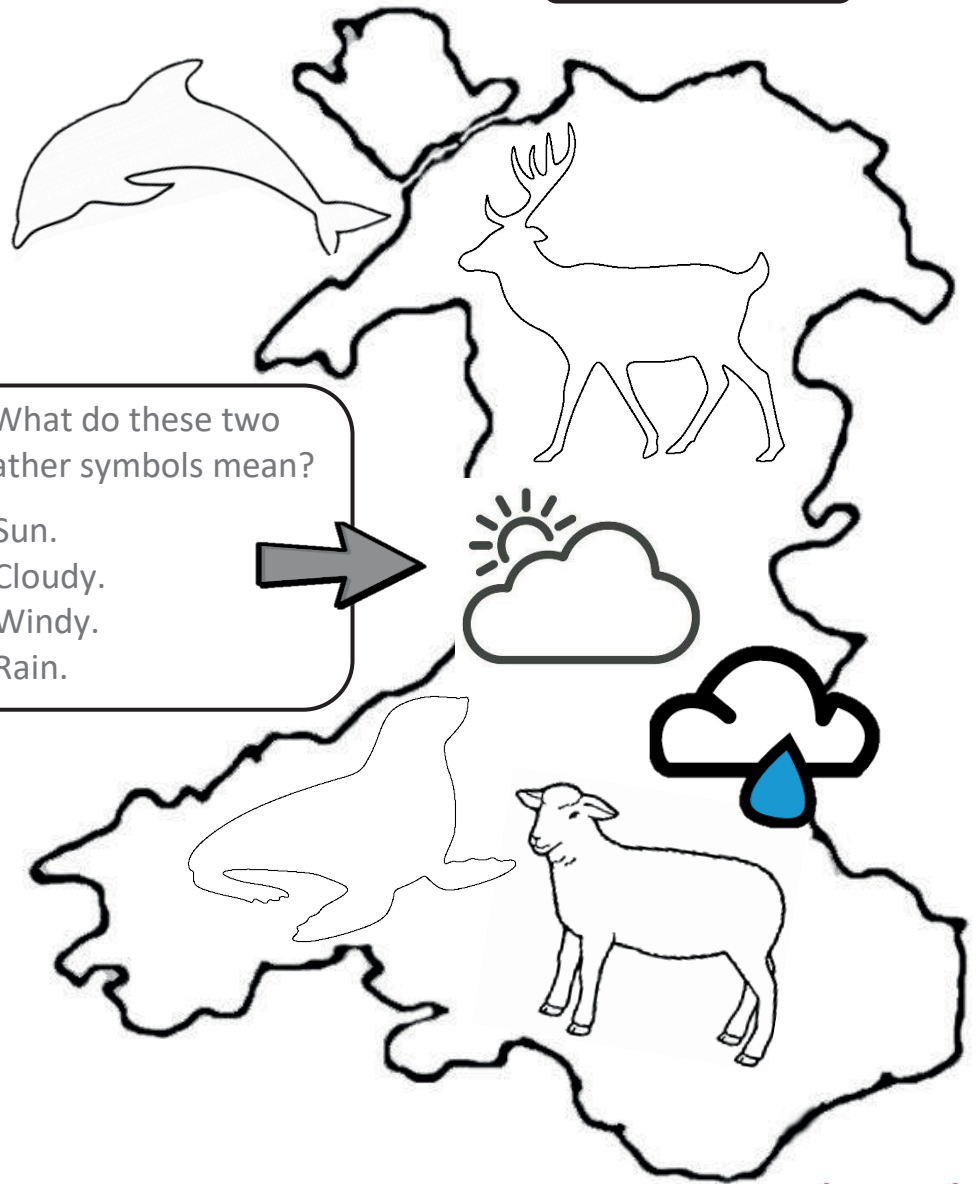
May all children
