Fil-bidu kienet diffiċli wisq għal Chen biex jaċċetta li ma setax iktar jimxi b'mod normali bħal qabel.

Meta t-tama dehret mitlufa, Chen instab mill-Isqof Kike Figaredo u t-tim taċ-Ċentru Arrupe. Illum il-ġurnata, Chen mhux biss ma jhossux ta' piż, imma qed igawdi suċċess akkademiku u professjonali. Fil-fatt, Chen qed jistudja l-iprogrammar tal-IT fl-università waqt li jaħdem fiċ-ċentru tat-tessuti 'La Paloma'.

Chen qed jingħata ċans iehor grazzi għaċ-Ċentru Arrupe u għal Missio li jgħin lil dan iċ-ċentru bis-saħħa tad-donazzjonijiet u l-qlub generuża tal-Maltin u l-Għawdxin.

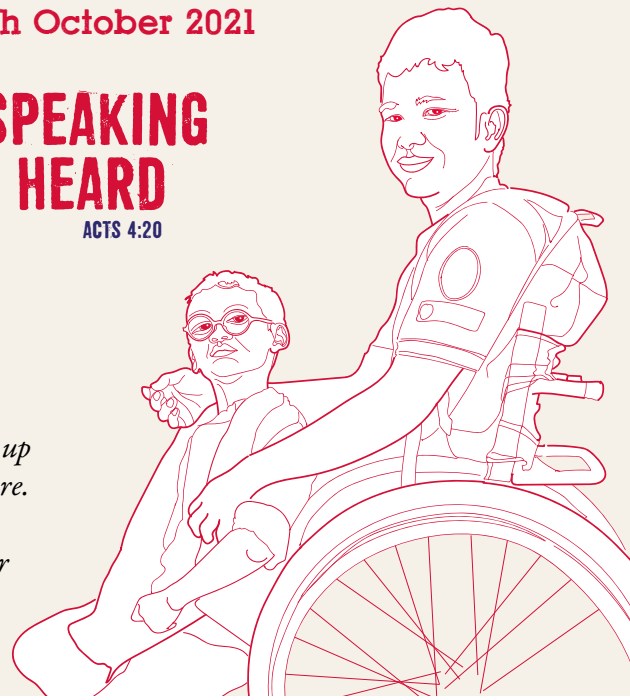

Between the 70s and 80s, millions of landmines were planted and hidden underground throughout all of Cambodia. As a result, a lot of children ended up being victims of such incidents and these disabilities somewhat limit their future.

As we are nearing the Missionary Month, I will take some time to share with you the story of 16-year-old Chen, who saw his life change overnight, when he stepped on a landmine that took both his legs. From a boy who happily went to school, helped his family on the farm and played football with his friends, Chen found himself with both physical and mental limitations as he began to feel a burden to his family who were already struggling financially. At first it was too difficult for Chen to accept that he could no longer walk normally as before.

When hope seemed lost, Chen was found by Bishop Kike Figaredo and the Arrupe Centre team. Nowadays, Chen not only does not feel a burden, but he is enjoying academic and professional success. In fact, Chen is studying IT programming at university while working at 'La Paloma' textile centre.

Chen is being given another chance thanks to the Arrupe Centre and to Missio who help this centre thanks to the donations and the generous hearts of the Maltese and Gozitans.
