Situation Needs

In these primary schools, the pressing need for improved waste disposal and sanitation is evident, with many facing challenges such as full or collapsed latrines and the shared use of limited facilities by students and teachers. This compromised environment not only jeopardizes the health of our students but also hinders regular attendance. Swift action is imperative to address these critical issues and create a hygienic and inclusive learning space for the children in our care.



Establish Sustainable Water Infrastructure:

Aim: To address the challenges of frequent power outages affecting the seminary's water supply by implementing a sustainable and independent water infrastructure, ensuring a reliable source for cooking, washing, and drinking.



Enhance Community Living Conditions:

Aim: To improve the living conditions of children, youths, and vulnerable adults within the seminary and the surrounding community by providing consistent access to clean and safe water, thereby promoting overall well-being.



Foster Collaborative Water Management:

Aim: To promote collaboration among the seminary community members and local residents, forming an effective team to address water scarcity challenges, explore efficient water-sharing mechanisms, and build a resilient water management system.

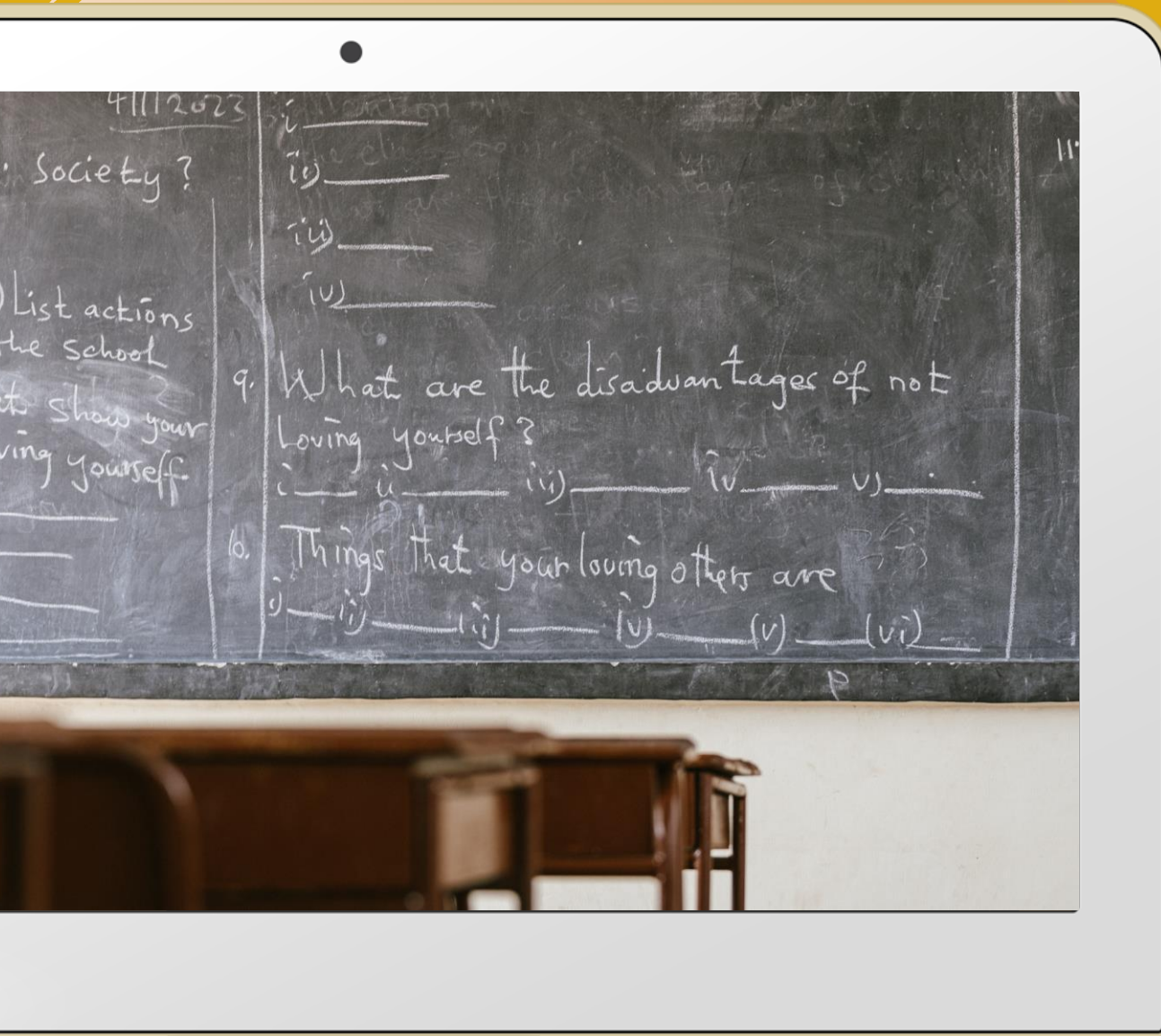


Expand Community Outreach and Evangelization:

Aim: To leverage the water project as a catalyst for community outreach and evangelization, serving approximately 500 people daily and engaging the broader community through spiritual programs facilitated by the seminary.

Project Aims

This project is driven by the urgent need to overcome water challenges exacerbated by frequent power outages in our country, disrupting the water supply to the seminary for extended periods. With aims to enhance water infrastructure, improve living conditions for children, youths, and vulnerable adults, and engage in community outreach and evangelization, the project seeks to serve approximately 500 people daily. By fostering team collaboration and supporting the ecclesiastical organization's mission, the initiative not only addresses immediate water scarcity issues but also contributes to a better quality of life, enabling students to focus on education and alleviating the burden of water-fetching for the surrounding villagers. The project's successful implementation promises a brighter and more sustainable future for the seminary and its broader community.



Project Social need

Project works including:

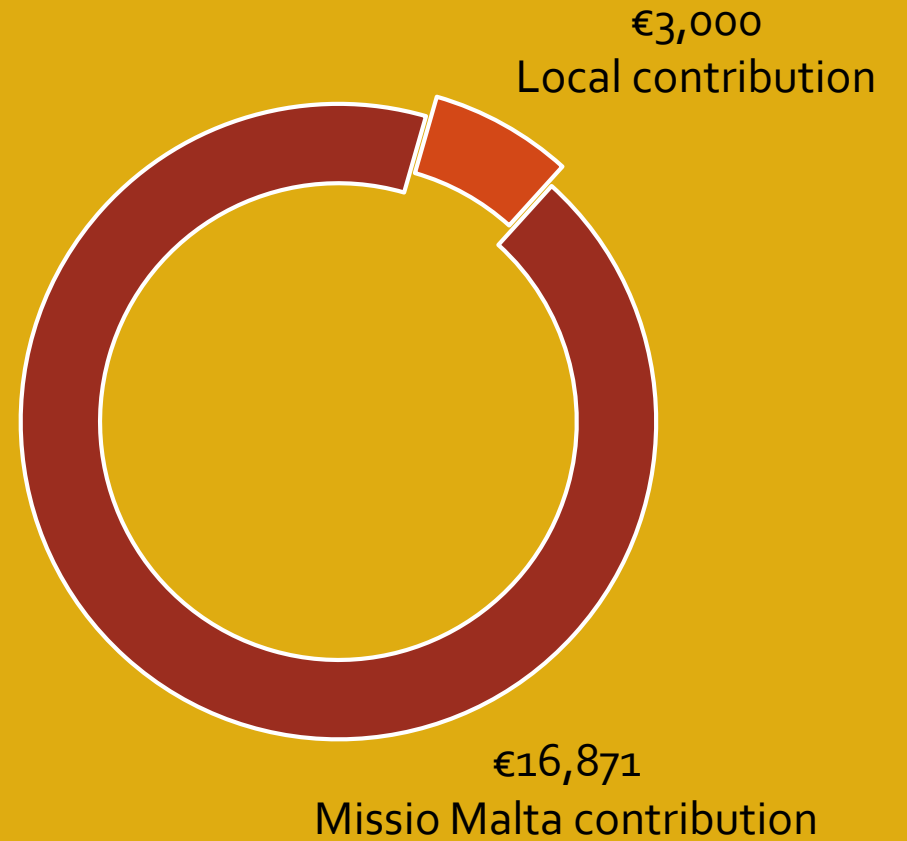
1. re-structuring water system by removing old rusting pipes and taps
2. creating the channel in which pipes will pass through
3. creating/building wells underground and piping systems which will help us collecting water during rain coming down from the main maintains
4. fixing of roof gutters to tap water during rain
5. supplying of water to the houses
