## **Situation Needs**

The community faces a profound challenge as waterborne illnesses, stemming from contaminated shallow wells, create serious socio-economic hardships. Women and girls bear the burden of fetching water over long distances, exacerbating the issue. However, the community's strength lies in its agricultural entrepreneurship, with farming as a primary income source. Introducing clean water through this project not only promises to alleviate health concerns, reducing mortality rates, but also holds potential for economic upliftment. The pressing need for the project is evident, driven by the escalating hospitalizations due to waterborne diseases and the community's awareness of the risks associated with unsafe drinking water.





Improve Access to Safe Drinking Water:

Aim: To increase access to safe drinking water in the communities affected by waterborne illnesses.




**Reduce Waterborne Illnesses:** 

Aim: To decrease the prevalence of waterborne illnesses in the communities.



Aim: To reduce the burden on women and girls related to fetching water and improve their overall well-being.



Increase Economic Productivity:

Aim: To boost economic productivity by addressing the impact of waterborne illnesses on people's health.

#### **Project Aims**



The aim is to alleviate socio-economic challenges caused by prevalent waterborne illnesses in communities lacking safe drinking water. The contamination, primarily from shallow wells, has led to increased hospitalizations and reduced economic productivity. The focus is on providing immediate access to clean water, promoting health education, and empowering the community to collectively combat waterborne diseases for improved socioeconomic conditions.



# Project Social need

The project is inclusive, respecting and refraining from any form of discrimination or interference with individuals' cultural or religious practices. Lumezi Project including:

- 1. Drilling of Boreholes in 3 locations
- 2. Set perimeter fences at locations of the 3 boreholes
